MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Chapter 136

Attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor covertenements numbers 50, 51, 52, and 53 at Saint Cataldus Street, Rabat.

The tenements are earmarked for public acquisition in connection with the project and reconstruction of St Paul's Church area.

The owners refused officials of the pertinent Department to enter into these premises with a view to inspecting and surveying the property in question.

Section 7 of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes)
Ordinance Chapter 136 empowers the Governor, when he
considers it desirable that any land should be examined
with a view to its possible acquisition for any public
purpose to make a declaration to that effect by him, and
thereafter it shall be lawful for any person either generally
or specially authorised by the Competent authority in that
behalf and for his assistance and workmen to:

- a) enter upon and survey and take levels of any such land;
 - b) to dig or bore under subsoil;
- c) to do all other acts necessary to ascertain whether the land is adapted for such purpose;
- d) to clear, set out and mark the boundaries of the land proposed to be taken and the intended line of work proposed to be made thereon.

Inspection and the taking of measurements of the said property is necessary for the continuation of the St Paul's Church areaprojected and Hon. Ministers are therefore invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR

In accordance with Section 7 (1) of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) I hereby declare that it is desirable that the land described below should be examined with a view to its possible acquisition for a public purpose.
