

Memorandum by the Acting Minister of Justice
Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap. 136

This is comparatively speaking a small plot of land measuring 11.1 square canes situated at St. Filomena Street, Kalkara.

It is intended to acquire by absolute purchase and the land is required for the widening of St. Filomena Street.

The acquisition is for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap. 136.

No immovable structures are involved and it emerges from the valuation report of the Land Engineer that the compensation in consideration of the freehold value relating to the property in question amounts to £64.15s.0d.

Honourable Members are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Kalkara.

A plot of land of the area of 11.1 square canes, bounded on the West and on the South by St. Filomena Street and on the North, on the North-East and on the East-South-East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Lawrence Boffa.

The above mentioned land is shown coloured yellow on a plan marked L.D. 180/64 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
