MEMORANDUM BY THE ACTING MINISTER OF JUSTICE

Land Acquisition (Public Purpose) Ordinance Cap. 136

The attached Declaration covers two plots of land involving two tenements at School Street, Qormi.

It is proposed to acquire by absolute purchase. The land is required in connection with the widening of School Street and for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Chapter 136.

The compensation in consideration of the freehold value has been assessed by the Land Engineer at £585. -s. -d.

The demolition and reinstatement expenses in connection with the re-alignment of these premises are to be borne by Government and are not therefore included in the above valuation.

Honourable Ministers are solicited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Qormi:

1. Part of Tenement No. 1, School Street corner with No. 129, Pinto Street, comprising part of a hall and part of a room, a room, part of stairwell, part of the yard and part of the garden, at ground-floor level of the area of 1237.5 square feet and that part of the said tenement overlying the property above described; it is the property of Miss Mary Curmi.

2. Part of Tenement No. 2, School Street, comprising part of a room, a small room, part of another room, part of the yard and part of another yard at ground-floor level, of the area of 888 square feet; it is the property of Professor J.M. Ganado, LL.D.

The abovementioned land is shown on plans marked L.D. 122/64 and L.D. 175/64 respectively, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, No. 29 South Street, Valletta.
