

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
LAND ACQUISITION (PUBLIC PURPOSES) ORDINANCE CHAP. 136

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General covers a plot of land at Attard.

It is proposed to acquire by absolute purchase and the plot of land measures 18.5 square canes. It is required in connection with the widening of Notary Zarb Street and consequently for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136). The only immovable property involved in the proposed acquisition is a rural structure.

It emerges from the report of the Land Engineer that freehold value of the land in question having regard to the value of similar land if sold on the open market has been assessed at £267.

Hon. Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Attard:

A plot of land of the area of 18.5 square canes including a rural structure, bounded on the North-West by Notary Zarb Street, on the South by Qormi Road and on the East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mrs Annunziata Gatt and others.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 162/64 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
