

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
LAND ACQUISITION (PUBLIC PURPOSES) ORDINANCE CHAP.136

The attached declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General covers a plot of land at Zabbar. It is proposed to acquire by absolute purchase.

The acquisition is for a public purpose in accordance with the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and the plot of land in question is required in connection with the widening of Bajjada Street, Zabbar.

No structures are involved in the proposed acquisition.

It emerges from the valuation report by the Land Engineer that the freehold value of the land in question having regard to the value of the land if sold on the open market and to all other factors concerned amounts to £186.15s. -d.

Honourable Ministers are solicited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Zebbar:-

A plot of land of the area of 22.41 square canes, bounded on the South-East and on the South-West by Bajjada Street and on the North-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the heirs of the late Noble Nicholino Trapani Galea and others.

The abovementioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 160/64 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
