

Memorandum by the Minister of Justice
Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance
(Chapter 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General covers a plot of land within the limits of Nadur, Gozo. It is proposed to acquire by title of absolute purchase.

The plot of land in question is required in connection with the erection of a water-tank. It is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Chapter 136. No immovable structures are involved in the proposed acquisition. The project aims at extending the existing water-tank and on the North-East it will extend to Xandriku Street.

It emerges from the valuation report drawn up by the Land Engineer that the freehold value of the plot of land under review amounts to £252. 0. 0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the under-mentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Nadur, Gozo:

A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 7.7 Kejllet, bounded on the North-East partly by Xandriku Street and partly by Government property, on the South-East by property of the Parish Church of Nadur and on the North-West and on the South-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Noble Marquis A. Apap Bologna.

The above-mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 177/64 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29 South Street, Valletta.
