

Memorandum by the Minister of Justice
Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance
(Chapter 136).

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor General covers a small plot of land within the limits of Victoria Gozo. It is proposed to acquire by title of absolute purchase for the purpose of widening Mgarr Road. The acquisition is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Ordinance) Chapter 136. No immovable structures are involved in the proposed acquisition.

It transpires from the valuation report drawn up by the land engineer that after taking into consideration the locality as well as other factors which could have a bearing on the value of the property in question the freehold value has been assessed at £13. 6s. 8d.

Honourable Members are solicited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Victoria, Gozo:-

A plot of land of the area of 5 kejllet bounded on the North by property of Mr. C.F. Parris on the West by Mgarr Road, on the South by property of Mrs. Theresa Attard and others and on the East by the remaining portion of the land of which it forms part; it is the property of Mr. Wigi Attard.

The above land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 11/65 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29 South Street, Valletta.
