## Memorandum by the Hon. Minister of Justice Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General covers three plots of land within the area of Hamrun. It is proposed to acquire by absolute purchase.

The land is required in connection with the construction of the Hamrun Bypass and consequently for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (public purposes) Ordinance Cap. 136.

No immovable structures are involved in the proposed acquisition.

It emerges from the report by Land Engineer that following an inspection in situ and after taking into consideration the locality as well as other factors which could have a bearing value of the land in question the freehold value has been estimated at £1952.0s.0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

## DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

## Description of the Land

The following land at Hamrun: -

- 1. A plot of land of the area of 2 Tmien, 4 Sieghan and 2 Kejliet, bounded on the West and on the South by Government property and on the North-East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mrs. Helen Miles.
- 2. A plot of land of the area of 4 Sieghan and 3.2 Kejliet bounded on the South partly by Government property and partly by property of Mr J.H. Zahra and others, on the Nest by Government property and on the North-East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Dr Vincent Depasquale LL.D.
- 3. A plot of land of the area of 2 Tmien, 2 Sie han and 4 Kejliet, bounded on the South-East by gormi Road, on the West by Government property and on the North-East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr J.M. Zahra and others.

The above-mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 101/65 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29 South Street, Valletta.
