

Memorandum by the Hon. Minister of Justice  
Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap. 136

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General covers two plots of land within the limits of Attard.

It is proposed to acquire by absolute purchase.

The two plots are required by Government in connection with continuation of a road linking Mosta Road with Rabat Road and therefore, for a public purpose in accordance with the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap. 136.

No immovable structures are involved in the proposed acquisition.

The Land Engineer in his report has assessed the freehold value of the property in question at £1,150. 0. 00.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Attard:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 26 square canes, bounded on the South by Notabile Road, on the East by property of the "Cassa Anime Purganti" attached to St. Paul's Parish Church of Rabat, and on the North by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Most Noble Baroness Frances Chesney Sceberras D'Amico Inguanez.
2. A plot of land of the area of 410 square canes, bounded on the South by Notabile Road, on the West partly by property of the Most Noble Baroness Frances Chesney Sceberras D'Amico Inguanez and partly by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part and on the East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the "Cassa Anime Purganti" attached to St. Paul's Parish Church of Rabat.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 84/65 which may be seen on request at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
