

Memorandum by the Minister of Justice

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance
(Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General covers two plots of land within the limits of Zabbar.

It is proposed to acquire by title of absolute purchase. The plots in question are required by Government in connection with the prolongation of Felice Street, Zabbar. It is therefore, required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap. 136.

No immovable structures are involved in the proposed acquisition.

It emerges from the report by the Land Engineer that having regard to the value of the land if sold on the open market and all other ancillary factors the freehold value of the property in question amounts to £68. 0s. 0d.

Honourable Ministers are solicited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Zabbar:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 54.56 square canes, bounded on the North by Felice Street, on the South by property of Mr. Salvatore Darmanin and others, and on the East and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the heirs of the late Anthony Cassar.

2. A plot of land of the area of 61.19 square canes, bounded on the North by property of the heirs of the late Anthony Cassar, on the South by Felice Street and on the East and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Salvatore Darmanin and others.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 130/65 which may be seen on request at the Land Office, 29 South Street, Valletta.
