

MEMORANDUM BY THE ACTING MINISTER OF JUSTICE

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap. 136

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General covers a plot of land which includes premises Nos. 104, 105, 106, 107, 108, 109, 110, and 111, Marsaxlokk Quay, at groundfloor level and the overlying space accessible from No. 103 Marsaxlokk Quay at Marsaxlokk.

The land in question is required by Government in connection with the erection of Fishermen's dwellings and therefore, for a public purpose in accordance with the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap. 136.

It is proposed to acquire by title of absolute purchase.

It emerges from the report by the Land Engineer that having regard to:

- a) similar land if sold on the open market;
- b) all other factors concerned;

the compensation in consideration of the freehold value for the outright purchase of the property in question would amount to £1,966. 13s.4d.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Marsaxlokk:

A plot of land of the area of 236 square canes, including premises Nos. 104, 105, 106, 107, 108, 109, 110 and 111, Marsaxlokk Quay, at ground-floor level and the overlying space, accessible from No. 103 Marsaxlokk Quay, bounded on the North by Tas-Silg Road, on the South by Marsaxlokk Quay, on the West by property of Mr Joseph Bonnici Mallia and on the East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Joseph Bonnici Mallia.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 179/65 which may be seen on request at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
