

Memorandum by the Minister of Justice
Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap. 136

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General covers a plot of land at Bugibba, within the limits of St. Paul's Bay.

It is proposed to acquire by title of absolute purchase.

No immovable structures are involved in the acquisition under review.

The land under review is being acquired for the conversion of the site into a public amenity. It is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap. 136.

The plot which comprises some salt pans and concrete ramp has been assessed in its freehold value by the land engineer in his report at £2,900.

Honourable Ministers are solicited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Bugibba, St. Paul's Bay:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 329.5 square canes, bounded on the South by a public road, and on the North and on the West by the foreshore; it is the property of the heirs of the late Mr Angelo Vella.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 199/64 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
