

Memorandum by the Hon. Minister of Justice

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap. 136

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General covers three parts of premises bearing numbers 47, 48 and 49 at Wied-is-Sir Street, Mosta.

It is proposed to acquire by title of absolute purchase. The land under review is required by Government in connection with the erection of a new school or rather the widening of the road approaching the Mosta New School. The land in question is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136).

It emerges from the report by the Land Engineer that the freehold value of the property in question would amount to £250.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Mosta:-

1. Part of premises No. 47, Wied-is-Sir Street, comprising a small room, part of open stairway and part of yard at ground floor level, of the area of 2.9 square canes, bounded on the South by Wied-is-Sir-Street, on the North and on the East by property of Mrs Regina Debono and others, and on the West by the remaining part of the said premises; it is the property of Mr Nicholas Galea.

2. Part of premises No. 48 Wied-is-Sir Street, comprising:-

(a) an entrance hall, part of a yard with open stairway, part of a small room and part of a larger room at ground floor level of the area of 13.67 square canes;

(b) part of an open terrace and part of a large room at first floor level of the area of 5.68 square canes; it is bounded on the South and on the East by Wied-is-Sir Street and on the West partly by property of Mr Nicholas Galea and partly by the remaining part of the said premises; it is the property of Mrs Regina Debono and others.

3. Part of store No. 49 Wied-is-Sir Street, of the area of 1.5 square canes, bounded on the East by Wied-is-Sir Street, on the South by property of Mrs Regina Debono and others and on the West by the remaining part of the said premises; it is the property of Mrs Regina Debono and others.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 126/65 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
