

Memorandum by the Hon. Minister of Justice
Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap.136

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General covers five plots of land within the limits of Attard. It is proposed to acquire by title of absolute purchase. No immovable structures are involved in the acquisition under review.

The site in question is required by Government in connection with the construction of a children's playground and therefore, for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap. 136.

It emerges from the report of the Land Engineer that having regard to the value of the land if sold on the open market would be valued at £537.10s.0d.

Honourable Ministers are solicited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Attard:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 5 Sieghan and 4 Kejliet, bounded on the North by Government property and on the East and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the "Cassa Anime Purganti" attached to St. Paul's Parish Church of Rabat, Malta.
2. A plot of land of the area of 2 Sieghan and 6 Kejliet, bounded on the West by property of Mr. Paul Gauci, on the East by property of the "Cassa Anime Purganti" attached to St. Paul's Parish Church of Rabat, Malta, and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Most Noble Baroness Frances Chesney Sceberas D'Amico Inguanez.
3. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 7 Kejliet, bounded on the West by property of Mr. Salvatore Ciappara, on the East by property of the Most Noble Baroness Frances Chesney Sceberas D'Amico Inguanez, and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part, it is the property of Mr. Paul Gauci.
4. A plot of land of the area of 1 Tonna, 3 Sieghan and 9 Kejliet, bounded on the North partly by property of Miss Grace Tonna and partly by property of Mr. George Cini, on the East partly by property of Mr. Salvatore Ciappara and of Mr. George Cini and partly by property of Mr. Paul Gauci, and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Salvatore Ciappara.
5. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 9 Kejliet, bounded on the East by property of Mr. George Cini, on the South by property of Mr. Salvatore Ciappara and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Miss Grace Tonna.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 148/65 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
