

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

Land acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance. Cap. 136.

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General covers three premises situated at Attard, St. Anthony Street and bearing numbers 49, 50 and 51/52.

It is proposed to acquire by absolute purchase.

The three premises are required by Government in connection with the widening of St. Anthony Street, Attard, and therefore, for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance, Cap. 136.

Having regard to:

- (a) the value of the land if sold on the open market;
- (b) all other factors concerned;

the land engineer has assessed the freehold of the premises at £2,300. It is to be noted in this connection that with regard to tenement number 50, St. Anthony Street, Attard, the valuation comprises both the perpetual utile dominium and the directum dominium.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the under-mentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Attard:-

1. Premises No. 49 St. Anthony Street, property of Mr. Joseph Fenech.
2. Premises No. 50, St. Anthony Street, property of Mr. Joseph Borg as regards the perpetual Utile Dominium and of the Parish Church of Lija as regards the Directum Dominium.
3. Premises No. 51/52 St. Anthony Street, property of Miss Giuseppina Mangion and others.

The above-mentioned land is shown on a plan marked LD.151/65 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
