

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
LAND ACQUISITION (PUBLIC PURPOSES) ORDINANCE CAP.136

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General covers a plot of land within the limits of Zurrieq.

It is proposed to acquire by absolute purchase.

No immovable structures are involved in the acquisition under review.

The land is required by Government in connection with the construction of a playing field in the area and therefore, for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap. 136.

It emerges from the report submitted by Land Engineer that the value of land in question if sold on the open market having regard to all other factors concerned would amount (freehold) to £12.3s.4d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE ACTING GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Zurrieq:-

A plot of land of the area of 7.3 kejllet, bounded on the East by property of the Parish Church of Zurrieq, on the West by property of Mr Gerald Farrugia, and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mrs Filomena Saydon.

The above mentioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 222/65 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29 South Street, Valletta.
