

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap.136

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General covers two premises bearing number 19 and 20/21 respectively, Immaculate Conception Street, Cospicua.

It is proposed to acquire by absolute purchase.

The land is required in connection with the reconstruction of the residual sight in New St. Michael Street, corner with Immaculate Conception Street, brought in the wake of the new alignment.

The land in question is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136).

It transpires from the report by the Land Engineer that after taking into consideration the locality as well as all other factors which could have a bearing on the value of the property in question its freehold value would amount to £330.0s.0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE ACTING GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Cospicua:-

1. Premises No. 19, Immaculate Conception Street, property of Miss Carmen Vella.
2. Premises No. 20/21, Immaculate Conception Street, property of Miss Anne Felice and others.

The above-mentioned premises are shown on a plan marked L.D. 206/65 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29 South Street, Valletta.
