

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap.136

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General covers three structural immovables within the limits of Birzebbugia, namely part of premises No. 79, Birzebbugia Road, consisting of part of a shop; shop No. 30, Birzebbugia Road and premises No. 81, Birzebbugia Road.

This property is required by Government for the purpose of widening Birzebbugia Road. It is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136).

It is proposed to acquire by absolute purchase.

It emerges from the report by the Land Engineer that after taking into consideration the locality as well as other factors which could have a bearing on the value of the property in question its freehold value would amount to £1,775.Os.Od.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE ACTING GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Birzebbugia:-

1. Part of premises No. 79, Birzebbugia Road, consisting of part of a shop of the area of 3.9 square canes at ground-floor level and the overlying area, bounded on the North by premises No. 80, Birzebbugia Road, on the East and on the South by Birzebbugia Road and on the West by the remaining part of the premises of which it forms part; it is the property of Mr Anthony Paris and others.
2. Shop No. 80, Birzebbugia Road, property of Messrs Anthony and William Montanaro.
3. Premises No. 81, Birzebbugia Road, property of Messrs Anthony and William Montanaro.

The above mentioned premises are shown on a plan marked L.D. 215/65 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29 South Street, Valletta.
