

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE  
LAND ACQUISITION (PUBLIC PURPOSES) ORDINANCE CAP. 136

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to five premises at Gudja, four of which are situated in St. Mark Street and one at Main Street. It is proposed to acquire by title of absolute purchase.

The premises in question are required by Government for the formation of a square and therefore, for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap. 136.

It transpires from the report submitted by the Land Engineer that the freehold value of the premises in question - having regard to the value of the land if sold on the open market and all other factors concerned - has been assessed at £1,480.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Gudja:-

1. Premises No. 1, St. Mark Street, corner with No. 117, Main Street, property of Mr Anthony Zahra.
2. Premises No. 118, Main Street, property of Mr. Anthony Zahra.
3. Premises No. 2, St. Mark Street, property of Mr Salvatore Dalli.
4. Premises No. 3, St. Mark Street, property of Mr Salvatore Dalli.
5. Premises No. 4, St. Mark Street, property of Mr. Sinphoviano Baldacchino.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 245/65 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29 South Street, Valletta.
