

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to two plots of land at Attard.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by outright purchase.

This land is required by the Government in connection with the construction of a car-park opposite the Villa Corinthia; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report submitted by the Land Engineer it transpires that, having regard to similar land if sold on the open market and to all other factors concerned, the total freehold value of the two plots of land in question amounts to £5,532.10s.0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Attard:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 164 square canes, bounded on the North-East by Long Street, on the South-East by property of Dr. Philip Attard Montalto and others and on the North-West by property of Mr. Francis Mamo; it is the property of Mr. Francis Mamo.

2. A plot of land of the area of 431.8 square canes, bounded on the North-West by property of Mr. Francis Mamo, on the North-East by Long Street and on the South-East by Birkirkara Road; it is the property of Dr. Philip Attard Montalto and others.

The above land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 107/66 which may be seen on request at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
