

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the imposition of an easement on a plot of land at Msida.

The easement consists in the laying of drain pipes in a trench across the said plot of land, and the acquisition is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report submitted by the Land Engineer it transpires that the compensation payable for the imposition of the above easement amounts to £2.10s. Od.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by way of the imposition thereon of the easement described hereunder.

Description of the Land

Easement consisting of the laying of drain pipes in a trench 39 feet long, 1 foot 6 inches wide and 1 foot deep following the gradient of the existing ground across a plot of land at Msida which is bounded on the West by Casolani Lane, on the South by property of Mr H. Gera de Petri and on the North-East partly by a new street off Antonio Sciortino Street and partly by property of Mr Paul Tabone; it is the property of Mr George Galea.

The above easement is shown on a plan marked L.D. 104/66 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
