

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

LAND ACQUISITION (PUBLIC PURPOSES) ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to premises at No. 65, St. Helen Street, Birkirkara.

Since these premises are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire them by outright purchase.

These premises are required by Government in connection with the improvement of the approaches to Birkirkara's Parish Church; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report submitted by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the premises in question amounts to £500. 0s. 0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL
