

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS.

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136)

The attached Declaration by the Governor-General refers to a plot of land at St. Julian's.

Since the plot of land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by outright purchase.

This plot of land is required in connection with the building of an electricity sub-station, it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the plot of land in question amounts to £121.13.4.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at St. Julian's :-

A plot of land of the area of 31 square canes, bounded on the West by Clares Street and on the North and on the South by property of the same owner; it is the property of Mr. Joseph Micallef.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 186/66 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office 29 South Street, Valletta.
