

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE  
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS.

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136)

The attached Declaration refers to a plot of land at Gnien Ingraw, Limits of Mellieha.

As this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

This land is required in connection with a storm water dam which has been constructed by the Water Works Department; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report of the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the land in question amounts to £15.10.0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL.

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Mellicha:

A plot of land of the area of 3 sieghan and 1 kejla, bounded on the North, on the South, on the East and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Marchese John Scicluna.

The above-mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D.157/64 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29 South Street, Valletta.
