

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE  
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS.

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to a plot of land at San Pawl tat-Targa, limits of Naxxar.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by outright purchase.

The plot of land in question is required by the Government for preserving a historical monument; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report submitted by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the land in question amounts to £750. 12. 0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land.

The following land at San Pawl tat-Targa limits of ~~Naxxar~~:-

A plot of land of the area of 75.06 square canes, bounded on the North-West by Birguma Road, on the South-West by Government property and on the South-East by property of Mrs. Rose Judge; it is the property of Mr. Gaetano Abdilla.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 86/66 which may be seen on request at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
