

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Aquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to a plot of land at Marsalforn, Gozo.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by outright purchase.

The plot of land in question is required by Government in connection with the erection of an electricity substation, it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Aquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report submitted by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the land in question amounts to £120.0. 0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Aquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Marsalforn, Gozo:-

A plot of land of the area of 9.65 square canes, bounded on the East by Marsalforn Road, on the North by property of Mr. Salvatore Vella and on the West and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Victor Azzopardi.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 15/66 which may be seen on request at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
