

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF  
JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS.

Land Acquisition(Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor General refers to premises at Nos. 59, 60, 61, 62 and 63, Belvedere Street, Gzira.

Since these premises are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire them by absolute purchase.

These premises are required by the Government for the purpose of widening Belvedere Street, they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report submitted by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above premises amounts to £2,200.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Gzira:-

1. Premises Nos. 59, 60, and 61, Belvedere Street corner with No. 132, The Strand, property of Mr. Joseph Camilleri.
2. Premises Nos. 62 and 63, Belvedere Street, property of the heirs of the late Carlo Camilleri.

The above mentioned premises are shown on a plan marked L.D. 191/66 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
