MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to three plots of land at Santa Venera.

Since these plots of land are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire them by outright purchase.

These plots are required by the Government for the purpose of road widening, they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the reports submitted by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of these plots amounts to £3,010. 7. 6.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Santa Vennera:-

- 1. A plot of land of the area of 76.3 square canes, bounded on the East by Fleur-de-Lys Road, on the South by Valletta Road and on the West by the remaining portion of theland of which this plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. John Gauci.
- 2. A plot of land of the area of 20.25 square canes, bounded on the North by Valletta Road, on the West by property of the heirs of the late Prof. E.C. Vassallo and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which this plot forms part; it is the property of Messrs. Dacoutros Bottling Company Ltd.
- 3. A plot of land of the area of 203 square canes including a farmhouse, bounded on the North by Valletta Road, on the East by property of Messrs. Dacoutros Bottling Company Ltd. and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which this plot forms part, it is the property of the heirs of the late Prof. E.C. Vassallo.
