

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE  
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS.

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to a plot of land at Nadur, Gozo.

Since this plot of land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

This plot of land is required by the Government in connection with the widening of the Nadur Road; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report submitted by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the plot of land in question amounts to £11.7.9.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

DESCRIPTION OF THE LAND

The following land at Nadur - Gozo.

A plot of land of the area of 29.03 square canes, bounded on the North by Nadur Road, on the West by property of Mrs. Vincenza Portelli and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Parish Church of Nadur as regards the Directum Dominium and held in perpetual emphyteusis by Mr. Francis Farrugia.

The above-mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 232/66 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29 South Street, Valletta.
