

MEMORANDUM BY THE HON. MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Changes in the design of uniforms
of the executive staff of the Courts

Reference is made to a previous memorandum on the subject.

It is suggested that the uniform for outdoor duties during Summer should do without the jacket and that a tie should be worn.

It is also suggested that the rank of the executive officer should be shown by means of stripes to be worn on the shoulder, as follows:

Usher-messenger	1 stripe
Usher	1½ stripes
Marshal (Criminal Court)	2 stripes
Marshal (Magistrates' Court)	2½ stripes
Marshal (Superior Courts)	3 stripes

(The senior marshals in the Superior Courts and in the Magistrates' Courts to carry a loop).

Honourable Members are invited to recommend.
