

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND  
PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor General refers to 6 plots of land at Msierah .

Since these plots of land are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire them by absolute purchase.

These plots are required by the Government in connection with the extension of the Msierah Industrial Estate; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report submitted by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the six plots in question amounts to £1032.4s.10d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Msierah:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 2 tumoli and 3.1 kejllet bounded on the North-West by an alley, on the North-East partly by an alley and partly by Government property and on the South-East by property in course of acquisition by Government; it is the property of the Parish Church of Balzan.
2. A plot of land of the area of 1 siegh and 7.3 kejllet, bounded on the North-West by an alley on the South by property of Mrs. Rosanna Pace and on the North-East by property of Captain Bernard Sant Cassia and others; it is the property of Mrs. Elena Grech and others.
3. A plot of land (including half an alley) of the area of 1 tumolo 4 sieghan and 8 kejllet, bounded on the South and on the North-West by an alley and on the North by property of Mrs. Elena Grech and others; it is the property of Mrs. Rosanna Pace.
4. A plot of land of the area of 2 tumoli 5 sieghan and 2.8 kejllet, bounded on the South by property of Major Henry E. Sant Cassia, on the South-East by property of the same owner and on the South-West partly by property of Mrs. Rosanna Pace and partly by property of Mrs. Elena Grech and others; it is the property of Captain Bernard Sant Cassia and others.
5. A plot of land of the area of 3 tumoli 3 sieghan and 6 kejllet, bounded on the West partly by property of Mrs. Rosanna Pace and partly by Government property, and on the North and on the South-East by property of Captain Bernard Sant Cassia and others; it is the property of Major Henry E. Sant Cassia.

6. A plot of land of the area of 3 tumoli 2 sieghan and 5 kejljet, bounded on the North-West partly by property of Major Henry E. Sant Cassia and partly by property of the same owner, on the South-East by property in course of acquisition by Government and on the North-East partly by property of Mr. Paola Vassallo and partly by property of Mrs. Fortunata Sciberras; it is the property of Captain Bernard Sant Cassia and others.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 188/66 which may be seen on request at the Land Office, 29 South Street, Valletta.
