

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND  
PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS.

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to 2 plots of land at Qormi.

Since these plots of land are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire them by absolute purchase.

These plots are required by the Government in connection with the widening of a public road; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report submitted by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the said two plots amounts to £438.18.9.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purpose) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

DESCRIPTION OF THE LAND

The following land at Qormi:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 74.46 square canes, bounded on the North, on the North-West and on the North-East by Wied it-Tigieg Lane and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Philip Muscat.

2. A plot of land of the area of 66 square canes, bounded on the North by Wied it-Tigieg Lane, on the West by tal-Handaq Road and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Parish Church of Mellieha.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 269/66 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
