

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE  
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS.

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to two premises in St. Paul's Street, Cospicua.

Since these premises are permanently required by Government, it is proposed to acquire them by absolute purchase.

These premises are required in connection with the scheme for St. Paul's Church Area; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the premises in question amounts to £1,335.0.0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

DESCRIPTION OF THE LAND

The following premises at Cospicua:-

1. Premises No. 94 St. Paul's Street property of Mr. Carlo Leone Ganado.
2. Premises No. 95 St. Paul Street property of Mrs. Sarah Leone Ganado.

The above mentioned premises are shown on a plan marked L.D. 345/66 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
