

MEMORANDUM BY THE OF JUSTICE AND
PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to premises at No. 15, Sanctuary Street, Zabbar.

As these premises are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire them by absolute purchase.

These premises are required by the Government for the purpose of road widening; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the above premises amounts to £300.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.
