

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to a plot of land in the limits of Zebbug, Malta.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

This plot of land is required for the purpose of road widening; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the calculation report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the value of the temporary Utile dominium (for the period of 35 years) amounts to £300. The directum dominium belongs to the Government.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

DESCRIPTION OF THE LAND

The following land in the limits of Zebbug, Malta:-

A plot of land of the area of 1 tomna and 5 kejllet, including a limekiln, bounded on the North-West by Valletta Road, on the South-West and on the North-East by Government property; it is the property of the Government of Malta, held on temporary emphyteusis by the heirs of Carmelo Grech.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 224/66 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
