

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE  
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the acquisition of a plot of land at Zurrieq.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

This plot of land is required for the purpose of road widening; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the plot of land in question amounts to £8.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

DESCRIPTION OF THE LAND

The following land at Zurrieq:-

A plot of land of the area of 3.78 square canes, bounded on the South-East and on the South-West by Qrendi Road and on the North-East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Francis Saydon with regard to the Directum Dominium and of Mr. Carmelo Camilleri with regard to the perpetual Utile Dominium.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 288/66 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
