

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND
PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS.

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the acquisition of three plots of land at Xaghra, Gozo.

Since the said land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

These plots of land are required for the building of a Police Station; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the said three plots of land amounts to £756.0.0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land.

The following land at Xaghra - Gozo.

1. A plot of land of the area of 17.46 square canes, bounded on the North-East and on the North-West by property of Messrs. Joseph and Anthony Sultana, on the South-East by an alley in Victory Square and on the South-West by property of Mr. Nazzareno Buhagiar; it is the property of Mr. Michael Angelo Azzopardi and of Mrs. Mary Rose Vella.
2. A plot of land of the area of 24.27 sq. canes, bounded on the North-East by property of Mr. Michael Angelo Azzopardi and of Mrs. Mary Rose Vella, on the North-West by Eight September Avenue, on the South-West by property of Mr. George Farrugia and on the South-East by an alley in Victory Square; it is the property of Mr. Nazzareno Buhagiar.
3. A plot of land of the area of 17.5 square canes, bounded on the South-West by property of Mr. Michael Angelo Azzopardi and of Mrs. Mary Rose Vella, on the South-East by an alley in Victory Square, on the North-West by Eight September Avenue and on the North-East by the remaining portion of the land of which this plot forms part; it is the property of Messrs Joseph and Anthony Sultana.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 358/66 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29 South Street, Valletta.
