

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS.

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor General refers to the compulsory acquisition of nine plots of land at Gharghur.

Since these plots of land are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire them by absolute purchase.

The said plots of land are required in connection with the formation of a new street at Gharghur, they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance, Chapter 136.

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the said nine plots of land amounts to £662.0.0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land.

The following land at Gharghur:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 3 Sieghan and 2.23 Kejliet, bounded on the North by New Street, on the South-West by property of the Dominican Friars of Rabat, and on the East and on the South-East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Parish Church of Gharghur as regards the Directum Dominium and of Mr. Carmelo Grech as regards the temporary Utile Dominium.
2. A plot of land of the area of 3 Sieghan and 4.8 Kejliet, bounded on the North-East by property of the Parish Church of Gharghur, on the South by property of Mr. Louis Fenech, and on the East and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Dominican Friars of Rabat.
3. A plot of land of the area of 4.2 Kejliet, bounded on the North by property of the Dominican Friars of Rabat, on the South by property of Mrs. Maria Bezzina and on the East and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Louis Fenech.
4. A plot of land of the area of 4.57 Kejliet, bounded on the North by property of Mr. Louis Fenech, on the South by property of Mr. Peter Bezzina, and on the East and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mrs. Maria Bezzina.

5. A plot of land of the area of 4 Kejliet, bounded on the North by property of Mrs. Maria Bezzina, on the South by property of Mrs. Giovanna Fenech and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Peter Bezzina.

6. A plot of land of the area of 8 Kejliet, bounded on the North by property of Mr. Peter Bezzina, on the South by property of Mr. Saviour Zarb and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mrs. Giovanna Fenech.

7. A plot of land of the area of 4 Kejliet, bounded on the North and on the West by property of Mrs. Giovanna Fenech, on the South by property of Mr. Saviour Zarb and on the East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Martin Bezzina.

8. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 4 Kejliet, bounded on the North in part by property of Mrs. Giovanna Fenech and in part by property of Mr. Martin Bezzina, on the South by property of Mrs. Bartholomea Fenech, and on the East and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Saviour Zarb.

9. A plot of land of the area of 2 Sieghan and 5.8 Kejliet bounded on the North by property of Mr. Saviour Zarb, on the South by "Ta' Peppi n-Nigru" Road, and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mrs. Bartholomea Fenech.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 380/66, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office - 29, South Street, Valletta.
