

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS.

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of four plots of land at Fgura.

Since the said land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The said four plots of land are required by the Government in connection with the construction of a car park; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above four plots of land at Fgura amounts to £300.0.0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Fgura:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 1.1 Kejllet, bounded on the North and on the West by property of Mr. Joseph Grech, on the East by property of the Carmelite Friars of Fgura, and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Gio Batta Curmi.
2. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 0.4 Kejllet, bounded on the North by property of Mr. Joseph Grech on the East by property of Mr. Joseph Tanti and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Carmelite Friars of Fgura.
3. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 7 Kejllet bounded on the North by property of Mr. Joseph Grech, on the West by property of the Carmelite Friars of Fgura, and on the East and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Joseph Tanti.
4. A plot of land of the area of 2 Tmien, 3 Sieghan and 1.5 Kejllet, bounded on the South in part by property of Mr. Gio Batta Curmi, in part by property of the Carmelite Friars of Fgura and in part

by property of Mr. Joseph Tanti, and on the North and on the East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Joseph Grech.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 366/66, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office - 29, South Street, Valletta.
