MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS.

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of a plot of land at Marsa.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

This plot of land is required by the Government in connection with road widening; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the plot of land in question amounts to £55.0.0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Marsa:-

A plot of land of the area of 1.84 square canes, bounded on the North and on the South East by Marsa Cross Road, and on the West and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Miss Theresa Chircop.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 14/67, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
