Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of a plot of land at Attard, which at present is the site of an old Cemetery.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The land in question is required by the Government in connection with road widening; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the land in question amounts to £175. 0. 0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Attard:-

A plot of land of the area of 17.5 square canes, bounded on the North-East and on the North-West by Birkirkara Road, on the South-West by property of Mr John Mallia and on the South-East by property of Mr Joseph Bruno Olivier; it is the property of the Parish Church of Attard.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 42/67, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office - 29, South Street, Valletta.
