

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of four plots of land at Msida.

Since the said land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The said plots of land are required by Government for the purpose of widening Valley Road, Msida; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above four plots of land amounts to £556.0.0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Msida:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 8.8 square canes, forming part of an open parapet of unnumbered premises named "Emily", in Valley Road bounded on the East by property of Mr. Francis A. Falzon, on the South by Valley Road and on the North by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Joseph Psaila.
2. A plot of land of the area of 7 square canes, bounded on the West by property of Mr. Joseph Psaila, on the South by Valley Road and on the North by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Francis A. Falzon.
3. A plot of land of the area of 5.53 square canes, forming part of the front garden of unnumbered premises named "Carousel", in Valley Road bounded on the West by property of Mr. Francis A. Falzon, on the South by Valley Road and on the North by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Frederick Doublet A. & C.E.

4. A plot of land of the area of 0.7 square canes, bounded on the West by property of Mr. Frederick Doublet A.& C.E., on the South by Valley Road and on the North by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Joseph Psaila.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 381/66 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
