

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of a plot of land at Luqa.

Since the said land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The plot of land is required in connection with industrial development, it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the plot of land in question amounts to £280. 0. 0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land.

The following land at Luqa:-

A plot of land of the area of 2 Tumoli and 2 Sieghan bounded on the West by a road, on the South and on the South-East by Government property and on the North-East by property of the Archiepiscopal Curia; it is the property of Mrs. Victoria Ellul.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 61/67, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office - 29, South Street, Valletta.
