

MEMORANDUM BY THE HON. MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of a plot of land at Qormi, which plot consists in part of the garden and part of the yard of tenement No.28, St Catherine Street, Qormi.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The said plot of land is required by the Government in connection with the formation of a new street; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the land in question amounts to £47.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Qormi:-

A plot of land of the area of 37.6 square canes, consisting of part of the garden and part of the yard of tenement No. 28, St. Catherine Street, bounded on the South in part by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part, in part by property of Mrs. Dolores Curmi and others, in part by property of Mr. George Brincat and in part by property of Mrs. Carmela Farrugia, on the West in part by property of Mrs. Dolores Curmi and others, in part by property of Mr. George Brincat and in part by property of Mrs. Carmela Farrugia, and on the North by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Anthony Baldacchino.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 10/67, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
