

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS.

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached two Declarations by His Excellency the Governor-General refer -

1. to the release of premises at Nos. 121 and 122, Two Gates Street, Senglea, and
2. to the compulsory acquisition of premises at Nos. 142 and 143, Two Gates Street, Senglea.

Premises at Nos. 121 and 122, Two Gates Street, Senglea, which had been declared as required for a public purpose by the competent authority by means of a Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General published on the 9th February, 1953, are no longer so required. The relative attached Declaration is intended for their release.

Premises at Nos. 142 and 143, Two Gates Street, Senglea, are required by the Government in connection with a reconstruction scheme; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136) and it is intended to acquire them on public tenure.

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the recognition rent of premises at No. 142 Two Gates Street, Senglea, amounts to £21.0.0 per annum, while that of premises at No. 143, Two Gates Street, Senglea amounts to £13. 6.0. per annum
