

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of part of premises Nos. 71/74, Main Street, Nadur, Gozo.

Since the said land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The said land is required by the Government for the purpose of widening Main Street, Nadur; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the land in question amounts to £550.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 130) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Nadur - Gozo:-

Part of premises numbered 71/74, Main Street, of the area of 28.61 square canes, consisting of a room having two entrance doors numbered 72 and 73 Main Street at ground floor level, of the area of 7.12 square canes and the overlying room at first floor level; part of another room having an entrance door numbered 74, Main Street, at ground floor level of the area of 1.81 square canes and the overlying part of another room at first floor level; and part of a yard having an entrance door numbered 71, Main Street, of the area of 19.68 square canes, altogether bounded on the North and on the West by Main Street, on the East by Dun Martin Street and on the South by the remaining portion of the said premises; it is the property of Mr Salvatore Ta'One.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 3/67, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
