

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE  
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of seven plots of land at Ghadira, limits of Mellieha.

Since the land in question is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The said land is required by the Government for the purpose of road improvement; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance, Chapter 136.

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above seven plots of land amounts to £2138.8.0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Ghadira, limits of Mellieha:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 184.2 square canes, bounded on the North and on the East by Marfa Road and on the South and on the South-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Doctor Alexander Depiro LL.D.

2. A plot of land of the area of 116.4 square canes, bounded on the North-West by property of Mr. Carmelo Borg and others, on the South-East by Marfa Road, and on the North and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Carmelo Vella.

3. A plot of land of the area of 66 square canes, bounded on the South-East by property of Mr. Carmelo Vella, on the South-West partly by property of Mr. Joseph Borg and others and partly by property of Mr. Edward Bonnici and others, and on the North by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Carmelo Borg and others.

4. A plot of land of the area of 27.6 square canes, bounded on the North by property of Mr. Edward Bonnici and others, on the North-East by property of Mr. Carmelo Borg and others and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Joseph Borg and others.

5. A plot of land of the area of 64.5 square canes, bounded on the South by property of Mr. Joseph Borg and others, on the North-East by property of Mr. Carmelo Borg and others, on the West by property of Mr. Carmelo Vella and on the North by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Edward Bonnici and others.

6. A plot of land of the area of 72.2 square canes, bounded on the East by property of Mr. Edward Bonnici and others on the West by property of Mr. Carmelo Vella and others and on the North and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Carmelo Vella.

7. A plot of land of the area of 208.9 square canes, bounded on the East by property of Mr. Carmelo Vella, on the South by Marfa Road and on the North by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot of land forms part; it is the property of Mr. Carmelo Vella and others.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 2/67, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
