

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of two plots of land at Naxxar.

Since the said plots of land are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire them by absolute purchase.

The above two plots of land are required by the Government in connection with road widening; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above two plots of land amounts to £695.15s.6d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the under-mentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Naxxar:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 93.63 square canes, bounded on the North East, on the East and South East by a public road and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which this plot forms part; it is the property of Mrs Josephine Strickland.

2. A plot of land of the area of 88.47 square canes, bounded on the North, on the South, and on the East by a public road and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which this plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Joseph Deguara.

The above-mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 87/67, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
