

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance, (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of three plots of land at Xaghra, Gozo.

Since these plots of land are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire them by absolute purchase.

The said plots of land are required by the Government for the purpose of widening the Victoria/Malsalforn Road, Gozo; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £120.13s.4d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Xaghra, Gozo:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 5 Sieghan and 4.1 Kejllet, bounded on the North by property of Mr John Elia Zammit Haber, on the East by Victoria/Malsafor Road, and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which this plot forms part; it is the property of the heirs of the late Mr Lorenzo Zammit Haber.

2. A plot of land of the area of 6.9 Kejllet, bounded on the South by property of the heirs of the late Mr Lorenzo Zammit Haber, on the East by Victoria/Malsafor Road, and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which this plot forms part; it is the property of Mr John Elia Zammit Haber.

3. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 1.4 Kejllet, bounded on the North and on the South by a public site, on the West by Victoria/Marsalforn Road and on the East by the remaining portion of the land of which this plot forms part; it is the property of the heirs of the late Mr Lorenzo Zammit Haber.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 114/67, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
