MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS.

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The enclosed draft Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of a plot of land at Nadur, Gozo.

Since the said plot of land is permanently required by the Government it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The said land is required by the Government for widening a public road; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the plot of land in question amounts to £11.3.10.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land.

The following land at Nadur - Gozo:-

A plot of land of the area of 28.65 square canes, bounded on the North by Nadur Road, on the East by property of Mr. Francis Farrugia and on the West by property of Mr. Joseph Camilleri; it is the property of the heirs of Mrs. Vincenza Portelli.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 88/67, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office - 29, South Street, Valletta.
